### Community:

CeDIn is a laboratory school affiliated to the Interamerican University of Puerto Rico in its Metro campus in San Juan. Its High School is situated inside the main campus and has access to all institutional facilities and services.

### Mission:

Our mission, as a Pre-school through Secondary Laboratory level School, is to provide a humanist education of excellence that is sensible the changing world and prepares our students for college, fosters their integral development, and provides a space for practice and exploration of the student's education and profession related to his/her conduct. The educational process is framed by universal Christian ecumenical values; the valuation of knowledge; exposure to the arts, technology and sports; and the development of a Culture of Peace.

### School:

CeDIn is a comprehensive four-year college preparatory school, belonging to a Christian private University. Our K-6 program began in September 2010 in "El Buen Pastor" with a total of 64 students. Faculty consisted of four teachers who collaborated with part time staff who offered Music, Art, English and Chapel. Pre-school remained in the University's campus during that year. The School generated the community's interest, for this reason the curricular program extended into the secondary level. On January 2011, CeDIn received the operating license for grades 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>. Population grew to 580 students that year. It is licensed by the "Consejo de Educación de Puerto Rico". CeDIn is a laboratory school under the supervision of the University's Department of Education and it serves as a practice center for college student teachers. Some courses are taught by University professors.

### Curriculum:

The academic program is organized on a rotating block schedule with a maximum load of 7 credits per semester. Each class block meets every other day for 90 minutes depending on the course. University level Biology & Chemistry Labs meet for 180 minutes. University courses, with credits are offered in: Biology, Geometry, Chemistry, Health, Christian Faith, Basic College Math; College Algebra & Pre- Calculus, Calculus, Health & Pre- Calculus, Calculus, Health & Psychology. Students taking these courses must meet the required grade average of 85 % (3.0) or more and are registered at the university as students. The faculty is required at least a Bachelor degree with more than half a Master degree. PH. D or J. D.

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### Enrollment

As of August 1st, 2019 the total enrollment of CeDI, grades 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>, consist of 329 students. Each class has an average size of 20 students.
